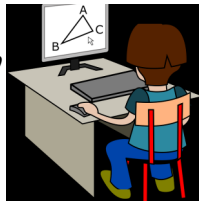


Grade: Current 1st–4th Grade

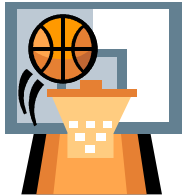
